As this is very much a work in progress, please visit the pages recommended below for a true idea of our direction.

In the search engine in the left hand column of the front page, you'll find small arms-related data for nearly 300 jurisdictions around the world. These include, where available:

- Clause-by-clause parsing of small arms legislation, import/export restrictions and other regulations (50 nations to date)
- Import/export procedures and transfer controls, marking, tracing and brokering
- UNPoA implementation, international assistance and support of civil society
- Interventions in place to remove obstacles to development and public health, such as weapon-free villages, domestic violence provisions, gun owner licensing, background checks, age limits

To see the full range of data being entered, go to Marcustan in Central Asia. Marcustan is a test page (non-existent country, bogus data), but from this you'll see where we're going.

In addition, AusAID and the Small Arms Survey have sponsored much more detailed narrative pages covering their nearest regions of interest, Oceania and South East Asia. For finished examples, please see Solomon Islands, Fiji, Brunei, Ukraine or Ireland.
