

**CHAN AND SUKUMARAN: Representations made by
Foreign Minister since 17 April 2005**

- 17 April 2005 **Sukumaran arrested at Melasti Hotel in Bali for possession of heroin. Chan arrested at Ngurah Rai airport in Bali on suspicion of attempting to smuggle heroin out of Bali.**
- 1 6 December 2005 Foreign Minister Downer raised issue with Indonesian Ambassador.
- 2 18 December 2005 Foreign Minister Downer wrote to Attorney-General.

Death Penalty: Sukumaran and Chan

- 25 14 April 2014 Foreign Minister Bishop raised issue with Foreign Minister Natalegawa. (P)
- 26 28 August 2014 Foreign Minister Bishop raised the issue with President Yudhoyono. (P)
- 29 November 2014 **Attorney-General Prasetyo confirmed that executions would take place 'before sunrise on 2015'.**
- 27 23 December 2014 Foreign Minister Bishop wrote to Foreign Minister Marsudi and State Secretary Pratikno. (W)
- 30 December 2014 **Sukumaran's clemency application rejected by President Widodo (letter received 7 January 2015).**
- 18 January 2015 **Indonesia executed six prisoners (Nigeria, Netherlands, Vietnam, Brazil and Indonesia).**
- 22 January 2015 **Chan's clemency application rejected by President Widodo.**
- 28 22 January 2015 Foreign Minister Bishop spoke with Foreign Minister Marsudi. (P)
- 29 29 January 2015 Joint letter from Foreign Minister/Shadow Foreign Minister/Leader of Greens to Foreign Minister Marsudi. (W)
- 30 January 2015 **Lawyers lodge second judicial review application.**
- 30 2 February 2015 Foreign Minister Bishop wrote to Foreign Minister Marsudi. (W)
- 4 February 2015 **Denpasar District Court rejected the applications for judicial review.**
- 4 February 2015 **Attorney-General Prasetyo said that the two men would be executed 'in February'.**
- 11 February 2015 **Lawyers for the two men lodged applications in the Indonesian Administrative Court in Jakarta seeking that their executions be stayed.**
- 31 13 February 2015 Foreign Minister Bishop spoke with Foreign Minister Marsudi. (P)

- 32 19 February 2015 Foreign Minister Bishop spoke to Vice President Kalla and proposed a possible anti-drug cooperation initiative. (P)
- 24 February 2015 **State Administrative Court of Indonesia rejected the application of 11 February which argued that the President had not considered the clemency bids adequately. Appeal hearing scheduled for 12 March.**
- 33 3 March 2015 Foreign Minister Bishop spoke to Foreign Minister Marsudi and proposed that Indonesia "pause" the execution process while the two governments explore a potential prisoner swap. (P)
- 4 March 2015 **Chan and Sukumaran were transferred from Kerobokan Prison to Nusa Kambangan.**
- 34 5 March 2015 Foreign Minister Bishop wrote to Foreign Minister Marsudi including on the possibility of a prisoner swap. (W)
- 35 25 March 2015 Foreign Minister Bishop wrote to Foreign Minister Marsudi. (W)
- 36 25 March 2015 Foreign Minister Bishop spoke to Indonesian Ambassador Nadjib. (P)
- 37 21 April 2015 Foreign Minister Bishop wrote to Foreign Minister Marsudi. (W)
- 25 April 2015 **Chan and Sukumaran were formally notified that they would be executed in 72 hours. Consular and family visits would be permitted until 28 April.**
- 38 26 April 2015 Foreign Minister Bishop spoke to Foreign Minister Marsudi. (P)
- 29 April 2015 Chan and Sukumaran, along with six other death row prisoners, were executed shortly after midnight. Philippines prisoner Mary Jane Fiesta Veloso was granted a last-minute reprieve after new evidence emerged in her case. French prisoner Serge Atlaoui's execution was stayed as he had an outstanding appeal pending in the State Administrative Court.
