

# MUTUAL DETERMINATION ON QUANTITATIVE EXPORT RESTRICTIONS

Dear Mr Jenner

Paragraph 1 of Article 8 of the Australia New Zealand Closer Economic Relations - Trade Agreement provides that the Member States shall take steps to reduce and eliminate quantitative export restrictions on trade in the Area in a manner to be mutually determined.

In the context of the discussions during the 1988 Review of the Agreement I propose therefore that, in accordance with the procedures set out in the exchange of letters of 7 and 15 December 1983, we mutually determine that quantitative export restrictions on trade in the Area be eliminated by 1 July 1990 at the latest.

In the case of ferrous scrap New Zealand will eliminate the quantitative export prohibition on 1 January 1989.

I would be grateful for your confirmation that the foregoing represents the understanding between the two Governments and will take effect from the date of your reply.
