Australian development assistance supports Tokelau to improve its educational outcomes.

Strategic direction

Australia works with New Zealand through a delegated cooperation arrangement to support development activities in Tokelau. The arrangement delivers better outcomes for Tokelau by improving donor coordination and reducing the administrative burden for the governments of Australia, New Zealand and Tokelau.

Australia's investments in the past fiscal year focused on improving education (SDG 3) in Tokelau and will expand to include health in 2019-20, which are key priorities of the *Tokelau National Strategic Plan 2016-20*.

Program highlights

- In 2018-19, illustrated Tokelau languages resources were printed and distributed to Tokelau's schools.
- In 2017-18, new Tokelau languages resources for schools were written and English literary materials were translated into the Tokelau language for use in schools.
