



New Colombo Plan

The New Colombo Plan is a signature initiative of the Australian Government, which aims to lift knowledge of the Indo-Pacific in Australia by supporting Australian undergraduates to study and undertake internships in the region.

Undergraduate students can apply for a scholarship program of up to 19 months, including study, internships or mentorships, and language training. A flexible mobility grants program offers short and longer-term study, internships, mentorships, practicums, and language studies.

The New Colombo Plan provides opportunities to live, study and work in 40 eligible locations in the Indo-Pacific region.

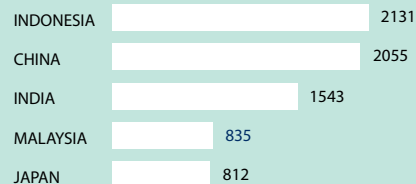
