

Universal Periodic Review Working Group – 33rd Session Universal Periodic Review of Costa Rica Statement by Australia 13 May 2019

Thank you [President/Vice President]

Australia recognises Costa Rica's efforts to improve its national framework for advancing human rights, making it a regional leader in this regard. While we commend progress since Costa Rica's second cycle review, further action is needed.

Australia recommends that Costa Rica:

- 1. Systematically address gender-based violence and expand the provision of legal aid and shelters for women and girls in need.
- 2. Take further measures to increase representation of women in the labour force.
- 3. Increase efforts to reduce the societal stigma faced by LGBTI people and eradicate involuntary surgical procedures to 'normalise' the bodies of intersex people.
- 4. Address ongoing racial inequality, particularly for indigenous and afro-Costa Rican communities, and adopt a coordinated strategy to combat child labour and sexual abuse among disadvantaged and migrant communities.
