## Universal Periodic Review of San Marino

Statement by Australia

Wednesday 6 November 2019

Thank you, [President/Vice President].

Australia commends San Marino on its strong human rights record and its robust human rights framework, which values the integrity of the person, affords a high degree of political participation and protects civil liberties.

Australia welcomes San Marino's progress in strengthening rights for LGBTI persons.

Australia recommends San Marino:

- 1. Considers further strengthening its legal framework, including on racial discrimination.
- 2. Takes steps to establish a national human rights institution compliant with the Paris Principles.
- 3. Continues to take steps to improve access to public buildings for persons with disability.
- 4. Accedes to the Optional Protocol to the Convention against Torture.
