## **EXCHANGE OF LETTERS**

UNDER THE PARTNERSHIP FRAMEWORK 2009-2013 BETWEEN THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION (WHO) REPRESENTED BY THE INDONESIA REGIONAL OFFICE / COUNTRY OFFICE AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA REPRESENTED BY THE AUSTRALIAN AGENCY FOR INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT (AUSAID) ON ACTIVITIES IN SUPPORT OF PUBLIC HEALTH IN THE INDONESIA REGION

- This letter initiates Exchange of Letters Number 50078/59143 between AusAID and the WHO Country Office in accordance with clauses 14 and 20 of the Partnership Framework 2009-2013. The Terms and Conditions contained in Attachment A of the Partnership Framework apply to this Exchange of Letters.
- The parties agree that the title of the Activity to be used in all documentation, correspondence and publicity is "Strengthening the Human Health Surveillance System for EID Detection and Response"
- AusAID offers to provide WHO Country Office with a contribution for the implementation of the Activity as described in the "Program Design Document" of January 2011 (attached) and any amendments agreed in writing by AusAID.

4 The contribution for all components as described in the Program Design Document (attached) is AUD2,600,000. Payment Schedule is as follows:

- 7 WHO Country Office will report to AusAID in accordance with the reporting requirements in the Partnership Framework, the Terms and Conditions and, any additional reporting requirements specified in this Exchange of Letters. AusAID will receive 6 monthly reports on the use of the funds from WHO. Three monthly updates will be given to AusAID by the Team Leader.
- 8 This Exchange of Letters will be deemed to commence on the date of receipt by AusAID of acceptance of this Exchange of Letters and will conclude on 30 June 2014.
- 9 Please indicate your acceptance of this Exchange of Letters by signing both original copies and returning one signed copy to AusAID.
