## His 22(1)(a)(ii)

We can provide the following points:

- For an entity to be listed as a **terrorist organisation**, the AFP Minister (the Attorney-General) must be satisfied on reasonable grounds that the organisation (a) is directly or indirectly engaged in, preparing, planning, assisting in or fostering the doing of a terrorist act; or (b) advocates the doing of a terrorist act.
- terrorist organisation means (a) an organisation that is directly or indirectly engaged in,

preparing, planning, assisting in or fostering the doing of a **terrorist act**; or (b) an organisation that is specified by the regulations.

- **organisation** means (relevantly to this part) (a) a body corporate; or (b) an unincorporated body; whether or not the body is based outside Australia, consists of persons who are not Australian citizens, or is part of a larger organisation
- terrorist act means an action or threat of action done or made with the intention of advancing a political, religious or ideological cause and with the intention of either (i) coercing, or influencing by intimidation, the government of the Commonwealth or a State, Territory or foreign country, or of part of a State, Territory or foreign country; or (ii) intimidating the public or a section of the public.

We note that in listing an organisation, the Attorney considers a range of legislative and non-legislative factors, which are outlined in the <u>Protocol for listing terrorist organisations</u> (<u>nationalsecurity.gov.au</u>), so the meeting of the legislative threshold would not be the only consideration.
