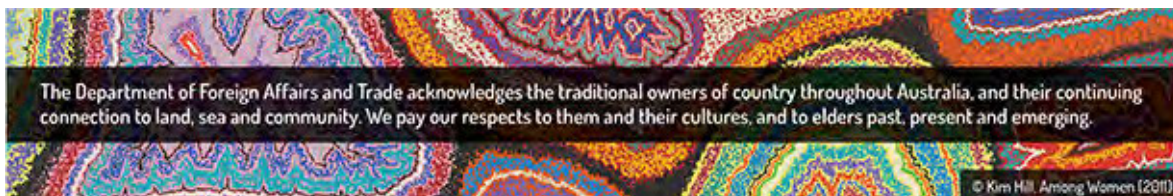

Dear Geoff

Thanks for sending through the current draft program.

I won't be available to do the transit on Monday 16 January, but will ask Consul s 22(1)(a)(ii) from my office, cc'd here to do that.

For the 11 hour transit on Sunday 22 January, we'd welcome a further discussion about the Ministers preferences for how he'd like to spend that day and possible options.

We note you've suggested a bilateral meeting with South By South West to discuss the Sydney event, but am not sure who you had in mind for that. There is no one in LA as far as we know who is working on that. Our consulate is working with the American Australian Association on Australia House for SXSW in March in Austin Texas (and all the SXSW team are based in Texas). The NSW State Government is leading all arrangements on the Sydney event, which is run separately.

Possible options for the Minister to freshen up and have executive/ Australia based business would be for him to book into a hotel for the day. We have special rates at the s 47E(d) , so if your/ Minister's budget and travelling party can extend to that, we can make that booking.

Should the Minister be interested, we could arrange a studio tour at one of the major studios investing in international screen production in Australia, such as Warner Bros or Universal. Both are representative of long term partners that include Disney, Paramount, Netflix and since 2018, investment by US studios in Australia, has amounted to some \$2 billion dollars and supported over 22,000 jobs. They are committed to the Australian market and investing in skills training, infrastructure and love our locations, crews, talent. As it's a Sunday, we may not be able to get a senior representative to speak with the Minister, but we could explore what might be possible if this is of interest. The studios are very keen to speak with a member of the new Australian government.

I could meet the Minister at the airport in the morning and s 22(1)(a)(ii) can assist his transit through LAX in the evening.

Would welcome a chat about all this ahead of my going on leave this Friday.

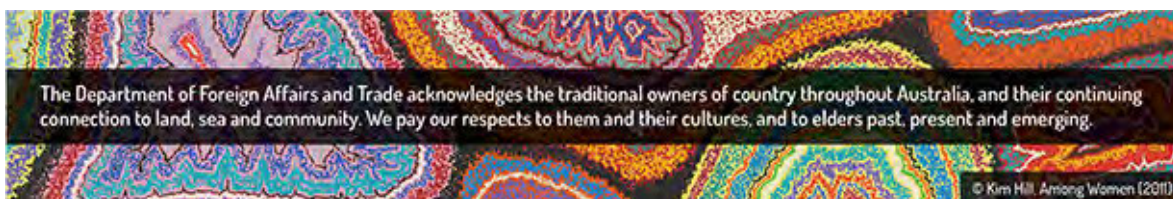

Note – I am working from my DFAT account. s 47E(d)

Please see attached a revised version of Minister Husic's travel schedule. It is starting to come together now.

Austrade - Jane/ s 22(1)(a)(ii)

- We will require Airport Facilitation on the 16th if possible?
- Not too add to the workload, but can we talk through what a visit to Google X could look like coordinated through Austrade. I think s 22(1)(a)(ii) has previously discussed that Austrade had good links within the organisation. CBR has asked that GoogleX visit be led with industry/startup focused perspective. Perhaps a call this morning your time? (s 47E(d))

Thanks for sending through the current draft program.

I won't be available to do the transit on Monday 16 January, but will ask Consul s 22(1)(a)(ii) from my office, cc'd here to do that.

For the 11 hour transit on Sunday 22 January, we'd welcome a further discussion about the Ministers preferences for how he'd like to spend that day and possible options.

We note you've suggested a bilateral meeting with South By South West to discuss the Sydney event, but am not sure who you had in mind for that. There is no one in LA as far as we know who is working on that. Our consulate is working with the American Australian Association on Australia House for SXSW in March in Austin Texas (and all the SXSW team are based in Texas). The NSW State Government is leading all arrangements on the Sydney event, which is run separately.

Possible options for the Minister to freshen up and have executive/ Australia based business would be for him to book into a hotel for the day. We have special rates at the s 47E(d) , so if your/ Minister's budget and travelling party can extend to that, we can make that booking.

Should the Minister be interested, we could arrange a studio tour at one of the major studios investing in international screen production in Australia, such as Warner Bros or Universal. Both are representative of long term partners that include Disney, Paramount, Netflix and since 2018, investment by US studios in Australia, has amounted to some \$2 billion dollars and supported over 22,000 jobs. They are committed to the Australian market and investing in skills training, infrastructure and love our locations, crews, talent. As it's a Sunday, we may not be able to get a senior representative to speak with the Minister, but we could explore what might be possible if this is of interest. The studios are very keen to speak with a member of the new Australian government.

I could meet the Minister at the airport in the morning and s 22(1)(a)(ii) can assist his transit through LAX in the evening.

Would welcome a chat about all this ahead of my going on leave this Friday.

Hi Geoff,

Good to connect to discuss Minister's Husic's time in Los Angeles later this month.

To assist with your preparations, I've attached a range of relevant docs:

- The invitation and draft agenda for the 27 Jan CEO Round Table
- The invitation and draft run of show for the 28 January Gala
- G'Day media points for use over the weekend

Welcome your advice about whether the minister can provide the remarks we've flagged in this draft CEO Round Table agenda. If he can, it would be helpful if he could address issues in his portfolio in a way that connects with the theme of the event – “navigating disruption.” That will ensure he sets the tone for the event well, and connects closely to the remarks other speakers will be delivering.

FYI, guests attending the event will represent large and emerging Australian and US companies in the tech, climate tech, screen, finance, aeronautical, tourism and logistics sectors. A number of those companies focus on disruptive technologies, for instance an Australian Quantum computing company, an Australian EV maker, and a US space companies seeking to invest in Australia. US companies present will be ones which already have investments in Australia, and Australian companies attending would similarly already have investments in California, so delivering messages about the ways his portfolio is supporting their success in each market would be well received. We can provide an RSVP list and bio pack in the days leading into the event.

Based on our prior engagements with these sectors, the Minister should expect to hear some participants discuss the importance of incentive programs in shaping their decisions to invest in the US and Australia. Australian climate technology companies enjoy significant growth in California because of generous policy and incentive support, now reinforced by the federal IRA. Screen companies will be focused on continuation of Australian incentive programs, and cite the roughly \$0.6B in FDI the screen sector brought to Australia in 2021-22, and the 20,000+ new direct jobs the sector has provided since 2018. They will note the impact of that sector significantly outstrips that of the gaming sector. Both the gaming and screen sectors will note the various overflow benefits and the way that each are a conduit for growth in interconnected sectors. We can provide some more info on the screen sector benefits in particular next week should it be of help.

We also mentioned in our call some other activities you could add to the Minister's program should he be interested. One is the VIP reception [Margot McKinney](#) will host for her high net worth clients on Friday night (Margot is a sponsor of the [Gala](#), thus is open to inviting some of our high level reps). Alternatively at the same time on Friday evening, the popular Australian kids program, Bluey, is doing a live premier stage show at Los Angeles' famous Dolby Theatre that night with a “blue carpet” reception. We could look into attendance by the Minister if

he'd find that a useful way to signal the success of Australian programming and the cultural affinity the show underlines between AU and US audiences.

Hope all of that's useful additional context and let's be in touch more as we prepare.

Thanks for sending through the current draft program.

I won't be available to do the transit on Monday 16 January, but will ask Consul s 22(1)(a)(ii) from my office, cc'd here to do that.

For the 11 hour transit on Sunday 22 January, we'd welcome a further discussion about the Ministers preferences for how he'd like to spend that day and possible options.

We note you've suggested a bilateral meeting with South By South West to discuss the Sydney event, but am not sure who you had in mind for that. There is no one in LA as far as we know who is working on that. Our consulate is working with the American Australian Association on Australia House for SXSW in March in Austin Texas (and all the SXSW team are based in Texas). The NSW State Government is leading all arrangements on the Sydney event, which is run separately.

Possible options for the Minister to freshen up and have executive/ Australia based business would be for him to book into a hotel for the day. We have special rates at the Beverly Hilton, so if your/ Minister's budget and travelling party can extend to that, we can make that booking.

Should the Minister be interested, we could arrange a studio tour at one of the major studios investing in international screen production in Australia, such as Warner Bros or Universal. Both are representative of long term partners that include Disney, Paramount, Netflix and since 2018, investment by US studios in Australia, has amounted to some \$2 billion dollars and supported over 22,000 jobs. They are committed to the Australian market and investing in skills training, infrastructure and love our locations, crews, talent. As it's a Sunday, we may not be able to get a senior representative to speak with the Minister, but we could explore what might be possible if this is of interest. The studios are very keen to speak with a member of the new Australian government.

I could meet the Minister at the airport in the morning and Cathy Arley can assist his transit through LAX in the evening.

Would welcome a chat about all this ahead of my going on leave this Friday.

It was good to chat to yourself and the LA team on Friday about the various upcoming visits to the US and LA.

As discussed:

- 1) s 22(1)(a)(ii) and I will submit the required airport facilitation requests, noting that s 22(1)(a)(ii) is the greeter for the international arrival.
 - a. s 22(1)(a)(ii) – I missed you on Friday. Can you please request the specific itinerary / tickets for the delegation? This allows us to be across the ticketing, which is particularly important for determining the locations where the baggage will need to be specifically managed.
 - b. Once we have the tickets, we can then provide instructions to the delegation for the return to Australia outbound transit through LAX.
 - c. I am very comfortable with the submission timing we have at the moment.
- 2) s 22(1)(a)(ii) **Geoff:** Once we have the tickets and itinerary document, we will be able to have a lot more certainty about lounge access. If for any reason lounge access needs to be purchased, this would need to be either a personal expense for each member of the party, or a departmental expense (9 times out of 10, this ends up being a departmental expense).
 - a. There is no provision to claim these costs backs as official costs for the trip.
 - b. Flagging this with you as LA Post would need to be reimbursed if they need to purchase access for the party. We always hold off purchasing access until entering the lounge, as for the times you purchase in advance, you can be guaranteed the inbound flight is delayed.
