Accommodation costs for participation in the LCIPP UNFCCC Forum (October 2023), Indian Ocean Conference (February 2024) and Australia-ASEAN Special Summit (March 2024) (Trips 10, 13 and 15) were paid for by the event organisers within another part of Government and were not charged back to the Ambassador for Climate Change budget.

From 2-5 August 2024, Ms Tilley travelled to Gove to attend the Garma Festival and support a visiting delegation of Pacific leaders. She flew from the Garma Festival to Fiji to attend the Pacific Islands Forum Senior Officials' and Foreign Ministers Meetings in Suva from 6-9 August. The domestic costs for the Garma trip were included in overall costs for the Fiji trip, reported in Lex11609 (travel dates 2-9 August 2024) and have not been included here, to avoid double-counting.

On 21 February 2023, Ms Tilley travelled to Melbourne for domestic meetings, before continuing to Sydney, to commence travel for an international trip to Fiji on 22 February 2023. The costs of domestic travel to Melbourne were included in overall costs for the Fiji trip, reported in LEX11609 (travel dates 21-25 February 2023) and have not been included here, to avoid double-counting.
