Please see the attached background brief on the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC), prepared by our Iran desk, along with a summary description below:

The IRGC operates as the ideological military-security arm of the Iranian regime, with a constitutional remit to uphold and preserve Iran's Islamic Republic system. The constitution provides that any duties and responsibilities surplus to this remit are to be determined by law. The IGRC is situated within the ideological wing of Iran's regime, and Iran's Supreme Leader has the power to appoint and dismiss the IRGC's leadership. The elected wing of Iran's regime, led by President Ebrahim Raisi, has no constitutionally derived oversight of the IRGC. The IRGC operates with complete independence from Iran's regular Armed Forces. In addition to its military role, the IRGC is involved in a number of non-government economic and political ventures, including considerable involvement in Iran's official and black market economies.

The IRGC operates as the ideological **military-security arm** of the Iranian regime, with a constitutional remit to uphold and preserve **Iran's Islamic Republic system**. The constitution provides that any duties and responsibilities surplus to this remit are to be determined by law. The IGRC is situated within the ideological wing of Iran's regime, and Iran's Supreme Leader has the power to appoint and dismiss the IRGC's leadership. The elected wing of Iran's regime, led by President Ebrahim Raisi, has no constitutionally derived oversight of the IRGC. The IRGC operates **with complete independence** from Iran's regular **Armed Forces**. In addition to its military role, § 33(a)(iii)


