The issues covered in the reports include information around the categories of protection under the Refugee Convention and Australian law (i.e. discrimination or violence on the basis of race/ethnicity/nationality, religion, membership of a particular social group and political opinion), complementary protection issues (i.e. arbitrary deprivation of life, death penalty, extent of torture and other cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment) and other issues relevant to protection decisions (extent of state protection, ability of people to relocate internally, treatment of returned people as failed asylum-seekers, extent of identification document fraud). The reports provide a general overview of conditions in a country, independent from Australia's foreign policy.
