Australia supports infrastructure investment that is transparent, inclusive and open and which will be delivered to a standard that will deliver long-term benefits, meets genuine needs, and avoids unsustainable debt burdens to Solomon Islands.

The release of the KPMG report is a matter for Solomon Islands Government. The report was not commissioned by Australia. We are, in response to a Solomon Islands Government request for telecommunications towers to improve communications along their western border, funding the construction of six towers across three provinces.
