Core funding support to UIS to develop education statistics

This will be done through building partnerships and cooperation, reviewing data sources and
- produce and implement new statistical standards, classifications, methodologies, mandate, through international standards based on best practice; provide guidance to Member States on how to monitor the areas of UNESCO's indicators and related documentation in the field of education. The UIS has a duty to
- develop the statistical and analytical capacity of Member States. The UIS will assist control, analysis and dissemination through training and other forms of support; countries to improve their capacities for education data collection, processing, quality
- provide analytical service within the context of the Institute's mission. The UIS will analyse and interpret cross-national education data; and work in partnership with a wide range of other researchers and data users in order to
- monitor Education for All. The UIS is the lead agency responsible for the collection of data and indicators to monitor Education for All (EFA) goals and the education-related collaboration with the EFA Global Monitoring Report team of the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs). They work in close
