Taking meaningful action to tackle climate change



- Responding to Tuvalu's drought and water insecurity
- Supporting the mobilisation of the **Tuvalu Coastal Adaptation Project** to protect Tuvalu from the impact of rising sea levels and cyclones
- Recruited a civil engineer to strengthen Tuvalu's public works capacity to progress climate change and non-climate change infrastructure projects



Over 140 Tuvaluan workers have participated in Australia's labour mobility programs since 2012 (as at March 2023)



Board member and contributor to the **Tuvalu Trust Fund** (average AUD1 million annually)



Supporting **gender equality** and **social inclusion** across a range of investments



Providing **fiscal support**, including extraordinary budget support in 2022-23 for post-COVID recovery and revitalisation



Proactively **responded to COVID-19**, including vaccines, technical advisers, nurses and procurement support



Provided a **Guardian-Class Patrol Boat** to support Tuvalu's sovereignty and protection of Exclusive Economic Zone and fisheries resources
