**The Review Team consisted of Professor Ingrid Moses (Team Leader) and Professor Terry Stokes.**

Professor Moses is currently Chancellor of the University of Canberra and was Vice-Chancellor of the University of New England, mid-1997 to early 2006 following a career as Professor of Higher Education, Pro and Deputy Vice-Chancellor. She served on the Council of the USP from 2001-2006.

Professor Stokes is currently Head of School of Government at Victoria University, Wellington, NZ. He has worked within federal and state bureaucracies and in academia, where his last position was Pro Vice-Chancellor (Academic and Research) at Central Queensland University.
